### **Public transport tickets in Vienna**

Besides the Vienna Card, the following tickets are available:

24-hour season ticket 60 ATS / 4,36 Euro  
72-hour season ticket 150 ATS / 10,90 Euro  
Single ride tickets 19 ATS / 1,38 Euro

These tickets are available at the ticket sales offices of the Vienna Transport Authority, at tobacconists and from vending machines in the underground stations; the 72-hour season ticket is also available in the Tourist Information Offices. Single tickets are also available from the vending machines in the vehicles themselves (including single-ticket surcharge altogether 22 ATS, have coins ready!).

The ticket sales offices of the Vienna Transport Authority (Wiener Linien) can also provide information about other forms of ticket and sell a map of the public transport network.
