Dr Dorsamy (Gansen) Pillay is the Deputy Chief Executive Officer responsible for leading the Research and Innovation Support and Advancement division of the National Research Foundation of South Africa. His career over more than three decades includes various academic, management and full professoriate positions at the former University of Durban-Westville (UD-W) and the Durban University of Technology in South Africa. He has spent time as Visiting Research Professor at Cornell University, USA; the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology in Australia; Goethe Universitat, Germany; and the Scottish Crops Research Institute in Invergowrie, Scotland. He obtained a post-M.Sc. qualification in Biophysics at the Weizmann Institute for Science in Rehovot, Israel, and a PhD degree in Microbiology from UD-W. Dr Pillay completed the *International Executive Development Programme* through WITS University, South Africa; the London School of Business; the Indian Institute of Management in Bangalore; the Harvard Business School (HBS) Programme on “*Maximising Your Leadership Potential*” and the “*Senior Executive Leadership Programme*” through Harvard University, USA. Dr Pillay is a Harvard alumnus. Dr Pillay is currently a member of the *Council of the International Institute for Applied Systems Analysis (IIASA)* in Austria where he serves as the Vice Chair.
