




#### Modelled Ash Concentration from FL000 to FL200 at 1200 UTC 17/05/2010

  - Equal efforts between CLE and MFR
  - European wide optimisation
- Methodology to analyse technical annexes
- Ex-post analysis baseline WGE/CBA
- Modelling climate impacts SLCF
- Uncertainty → flexibility mechanisms

- EMEP → approved co-chair
- WGSR/EB → Draft protocol text + annexes

  - Include ammonia options?
  - Guidance on uncertainties from TFEIP
- EB → Long term strategy
