5 components:-

- 1. Future projections of atmospheric emissions
- 2. Atmospheric modelling
- 3. Environmental impacts
- 4. Potential measures to reduce emissions (including non-tech measures and behavioural change)
- 5. Integration of the above in policy context+ critical review
- Prelim. assess ~mid November; if yes proceed to full proposal
